



Delaware ranked 47th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. <1.0% (89) of the RA population for FY23 transitioned to Delaware.

*MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders. A Micropolitan Area has a population center of at least 10,000 but less than 50,000 (Census Bureau). N/A Rural describes an area that is considered a Micropolitan Area, or less in population. Some of the MSAs split states but the numbers only reflect DE. **ALL** data represents **ONLY** those with Honorable/general service.












Demographics of the 252 soldiers that transitioned to Delaware in FY23.
