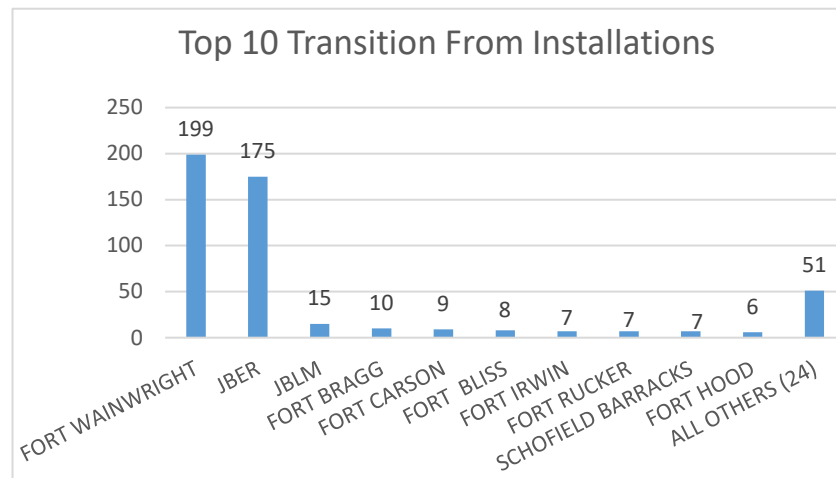
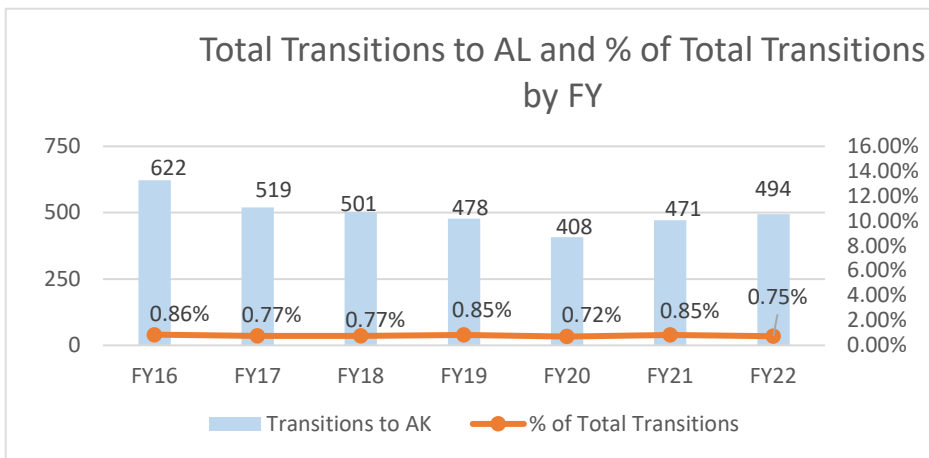
Alaska ranked 29th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 1.0% (494) of the RA population for FY22 transitioned to Alaska.

## AK FY22 RA Transitions

- **65,864** (left the Army)

- **62** (returned to AK; **about 63% loss**)
- **432** (outsiders moved to AK)
- ❖ **494** to AK



\* MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders. A Micropolitan Area has a population center of at least 10,000 but less than 50,000 (Census Bureau).  
 \*\* represents an installation at that MSA.

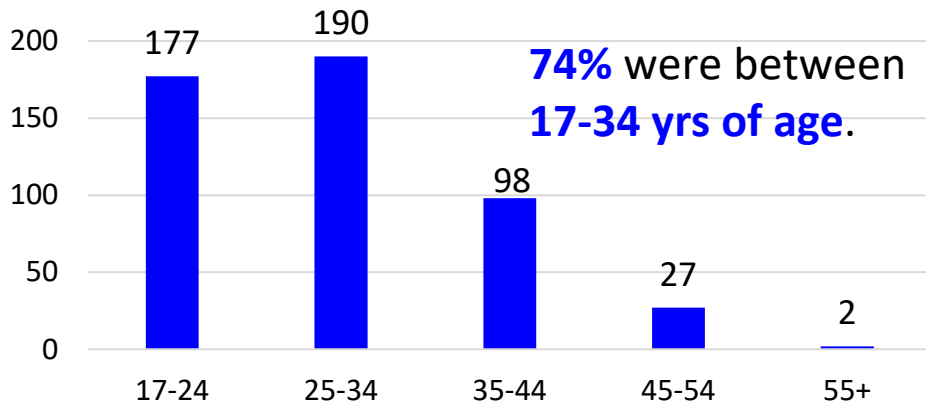

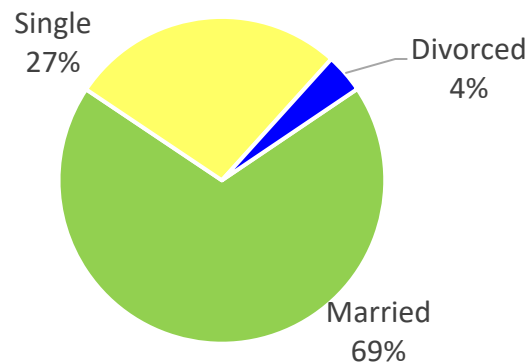


Demographics of the 494 RA soldiers that transitioned to Alaska in FY22.

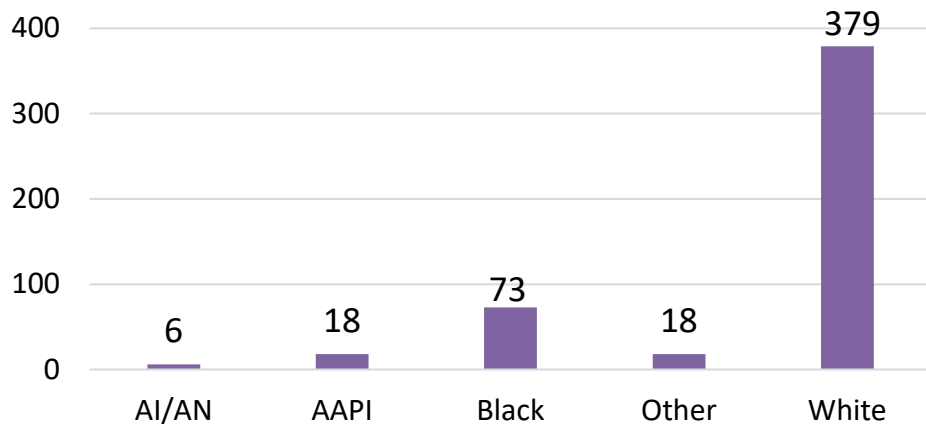
## Age



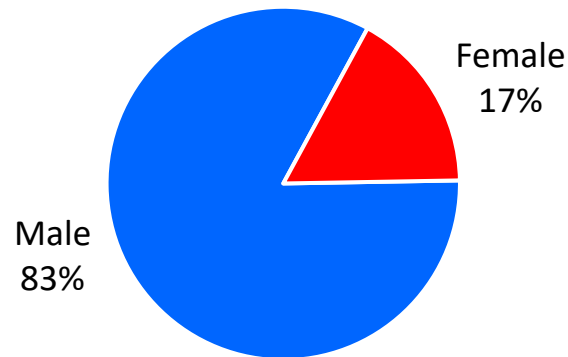
## Marital Status
