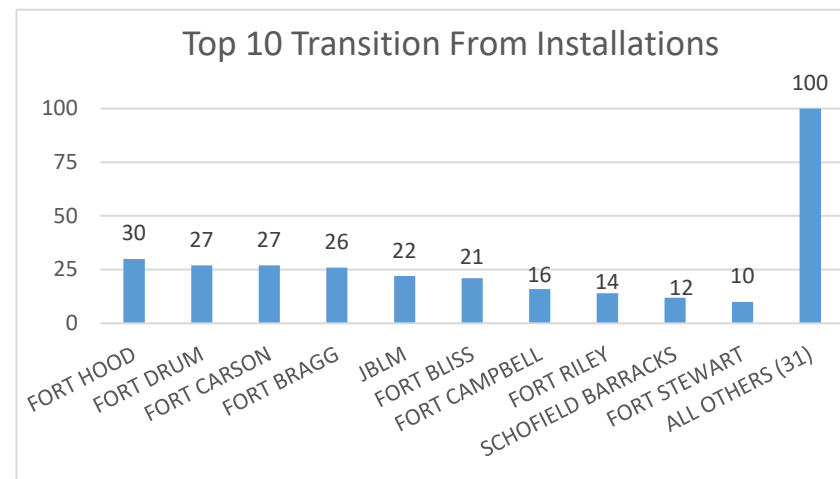
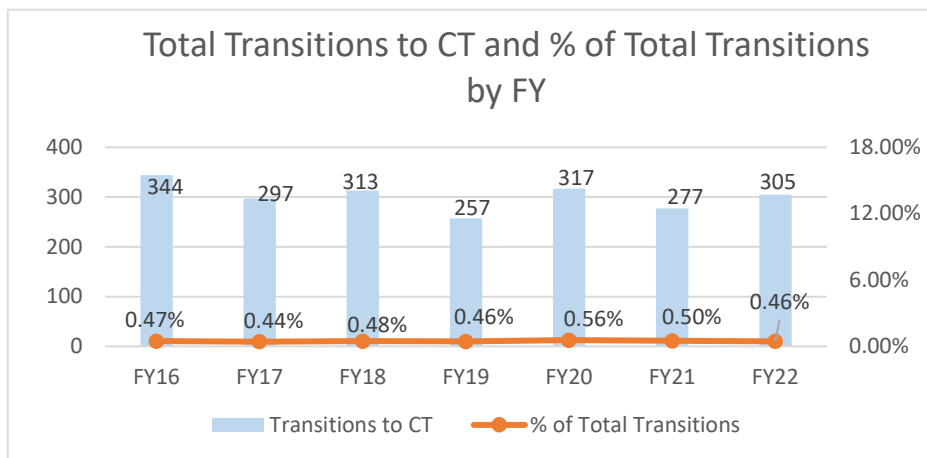


Connecticut ranked 38th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. <1.0% (305) of the RA population for FY22 transitioned to Connecticut.

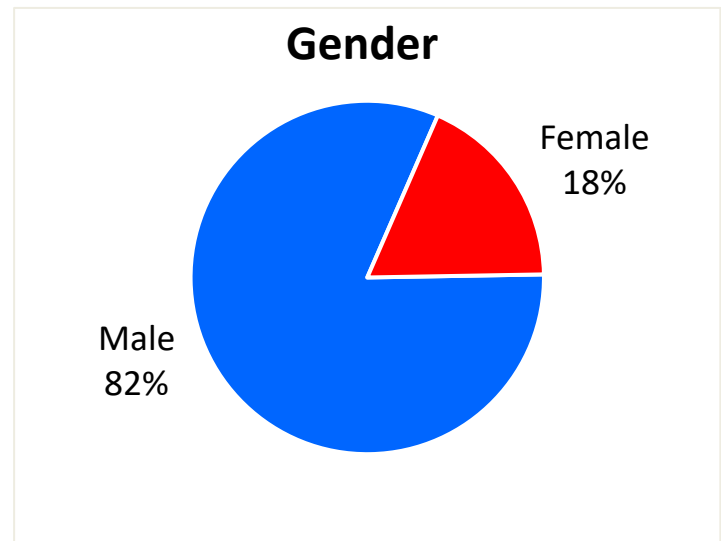
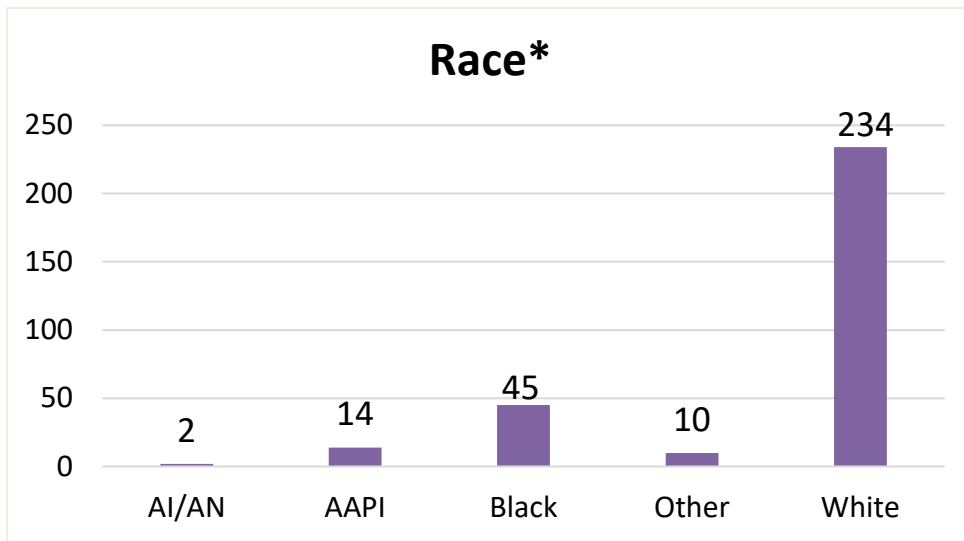
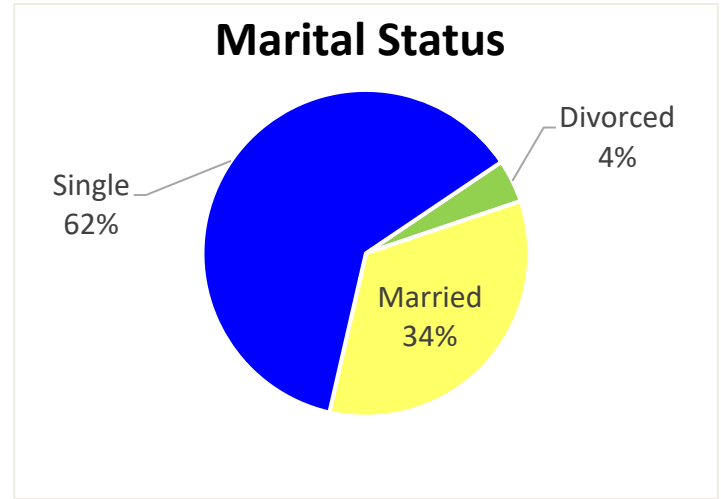
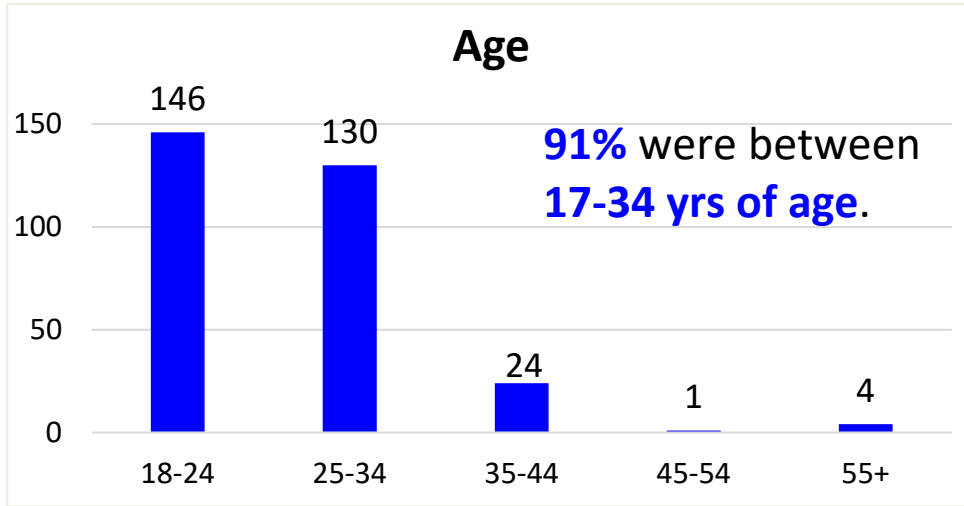
