



Connecticut ranked 38th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. <1.0% (305) of the RA population for FY22 transitioned to Connecticut.

- > 65,864 (left the Army)

- **305** to CT






<sup>\*</sup>MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders (Census Bureau). Some of the MSAs split states but the numbers only reflect the CT side of the MSA.









Demographics of the 305 RA soldiers that transitioned to Connecticut in FY22.
