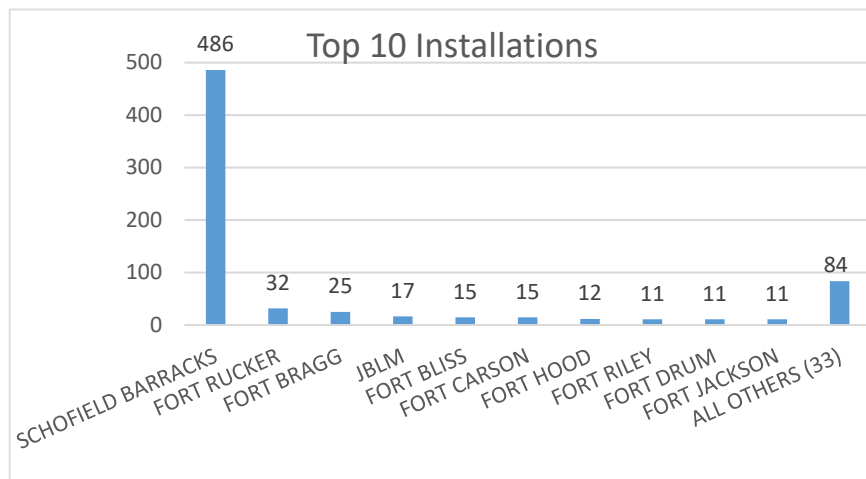
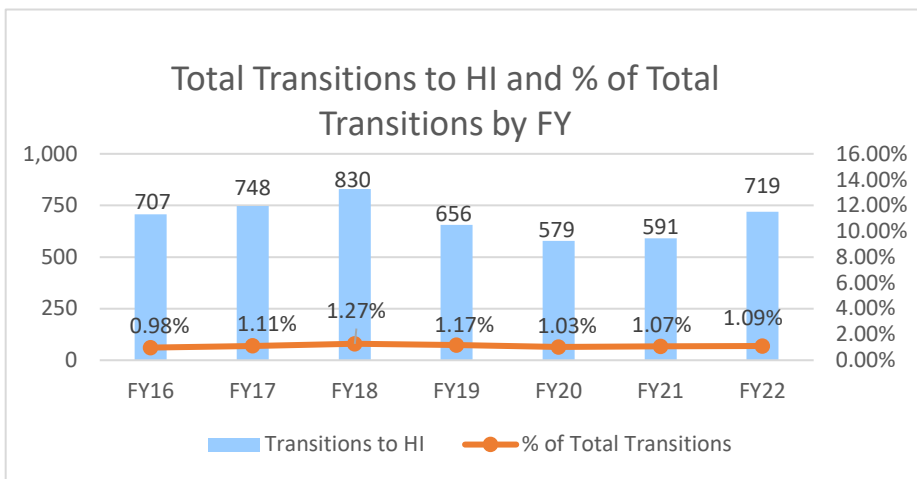


Hawaii ranked 25th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 1.1% (719) of the RA population for FY22 transitioned to Hawaii.

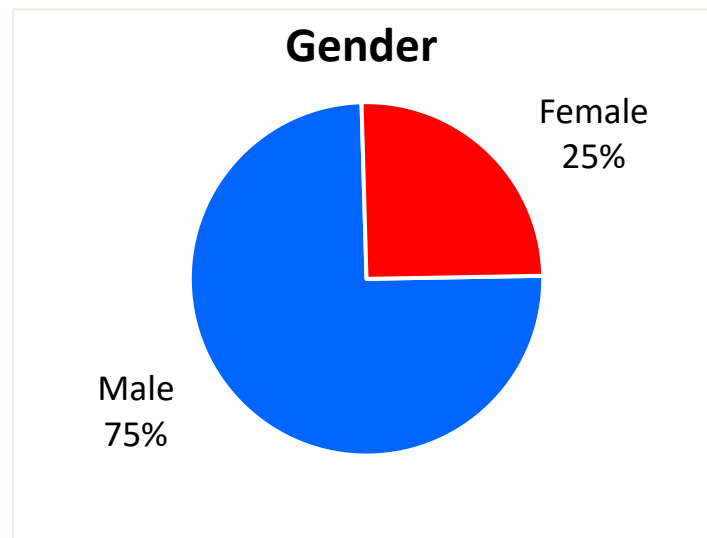
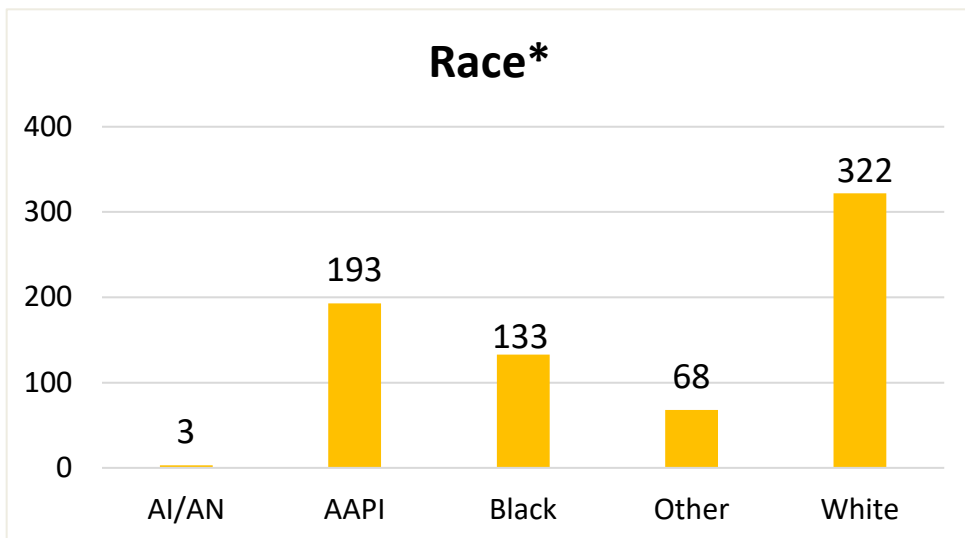
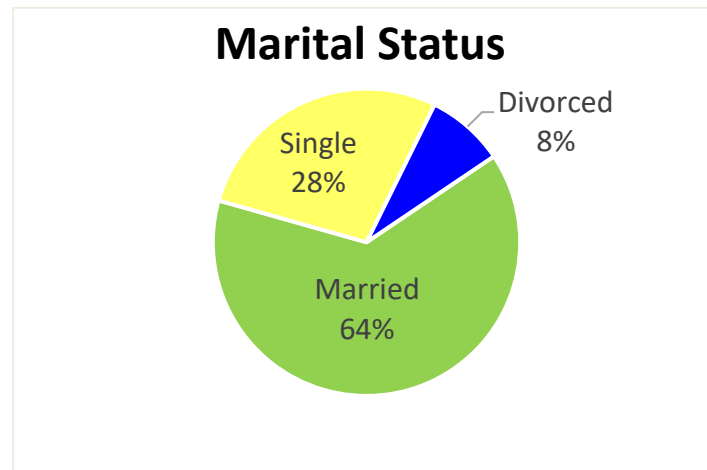
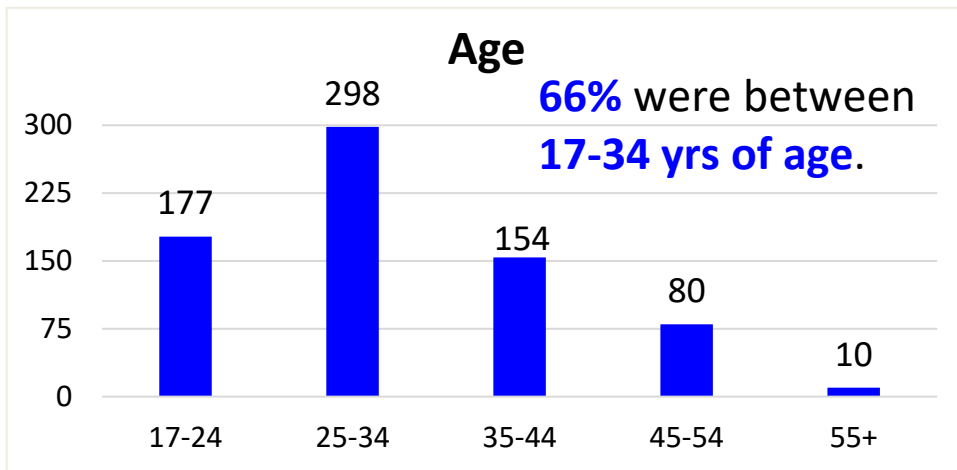
