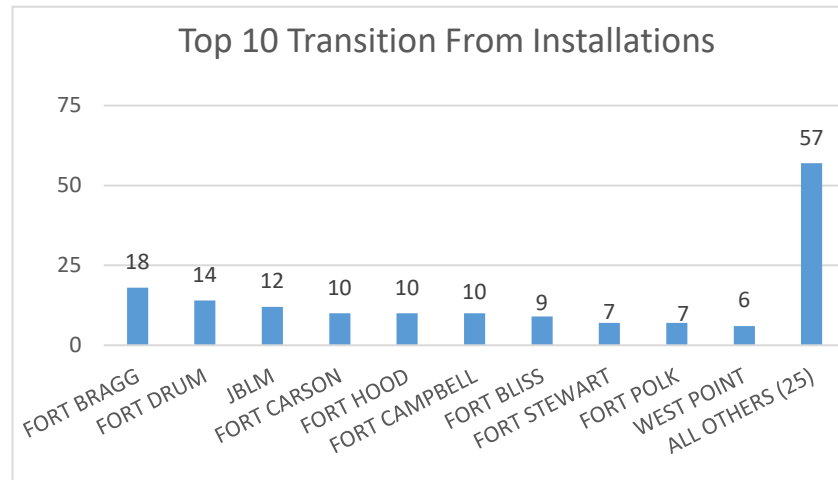
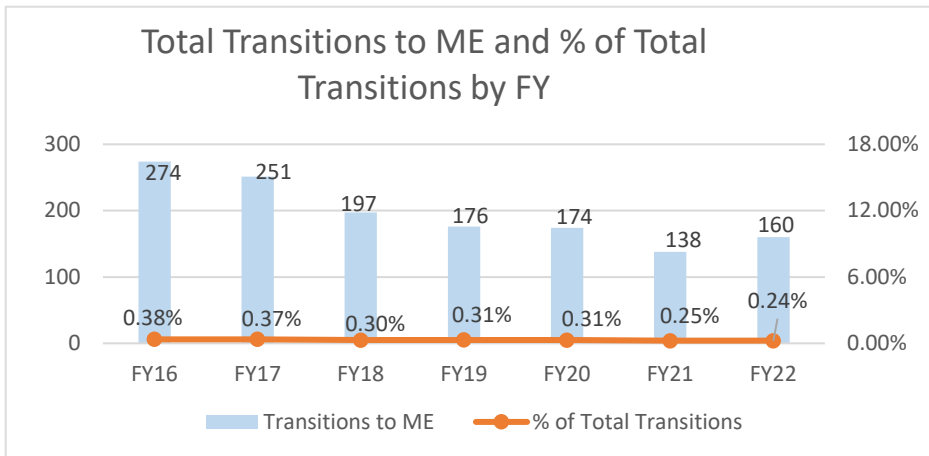
Maine ranked 45th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. <1.0% (160) of the RA population for FY22 transitioned to Maine.

MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders. A Micropolitan Area has a population center of at least 10,000 but less than 50,000 (Census Bureau).



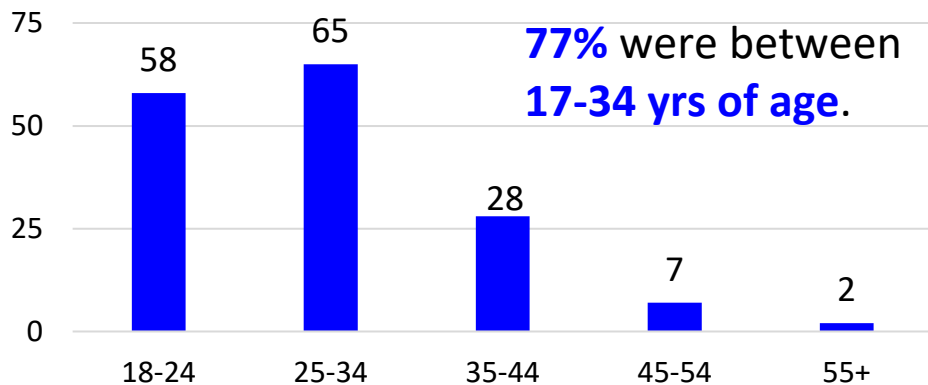

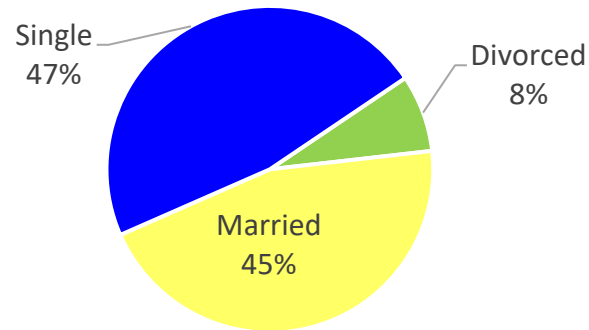
Demographics of the 160 RA soldiers that transitioned to Maine in FY22.

## Age

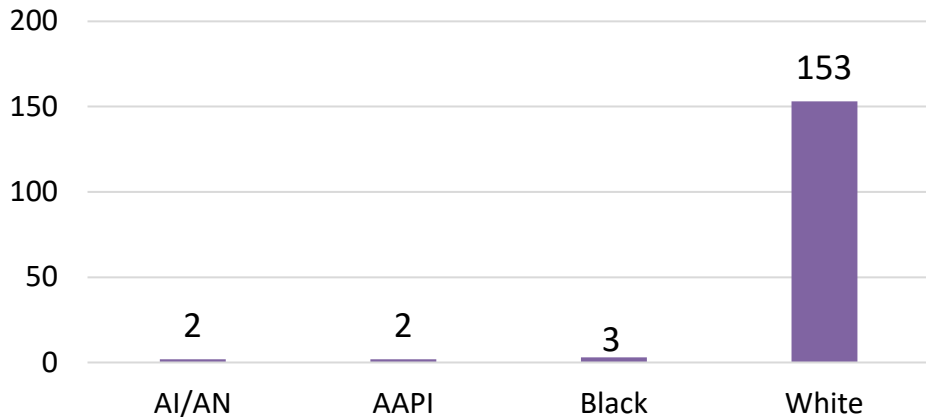
77% were between 17-34 yrs of age.



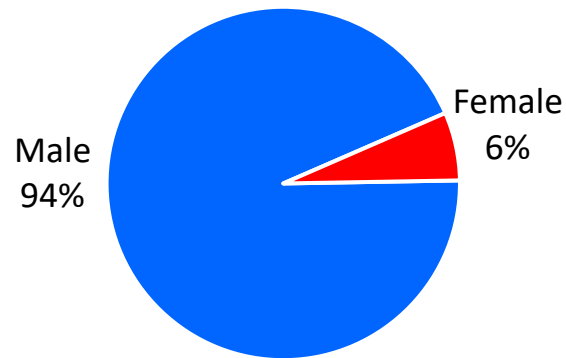
## Marital Status
