





Maryland ranked 12th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 2% (1,455) of the RA population for FY22 transitioned to Maryland.





*MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders (Census Bureau). Some MSAs split states however the numbers only reflect those that transitioned to the MD side of the MSA. ** represents an installation at that MSA.












Demographics of the 1,455 RA soldiers that transitioned to Maryland in FY22.










