


Mississippi



Mississippi ranked 32nd in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. <1% (436) of the RA population for FY22 transitioned to Mississippi.



- **436** to MS




^{*} MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders. A Micropolitan Area has a population center of at least 10,000 but less than 50,000 (Census Bureau). Some of the MSAs split states but the numbers only reflect the MS side of the MSA.









Demographics of the 436 RA soldiers that transitioned to Mississippi in FY22.
