


Montana



Montana ranked 44th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. <1.0% (175) of the RA population for FY22 transitioned to Montana.





- **175** to MT






^{*} MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders. A Micropolitan Area has a population center of at least 10,000 but less than 50,000 (Census Bureau).









Demographics of the 175 RA soldiers that transitioned to Montana in FY22.
