



North Carolina ranked 2nd in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 7% (4,533) of the RA population for FY22 transitioned to North Carolina.

NC FY22 RA Transitions

- > 65,864 (left the Army)
- > **2,922** (Joined in NC)
- > 1,526 (returned to NC; about 48% loss)
- > 3,007 (outsiders moved to NC)
- **4,533** to NC





^{*}MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders (Census Bureau). Some MSAs split states however the numbers only reflect those that transitioned to the NC side of the MSA.











Demographics of the 4,533 RA soldiers that transitioned to North Carolina in FY22.
