



Utah ranked 36th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 1.0% (328) of the RA population for FY22 transitioned to Utah.

- **328** to UT






^{*}MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders (Census Bureau). Some MSAs split states however the numbers only reflect those that transitioned to the UT side of the MSA.









Demographics of the 328 RA soldiers that transitioned to Utah in FY22.
