



Virginia ranked 7th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 4% (2,651) of the RA population for FY22 transitioned to Virginia.

## **VA FY22 RA Transitions**

- $\geq$  65,864 (left the Army)
- > **1,744** (Joined in VA)
- 681 (returned to VA; about 61% loss)
- > 1,970 (outsiders moved to VA)
- **2,651** to VA





<sup>\*</sup>MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders (Census Bureau). Some MSAs split states however the numbers only reflect those that transitioned to the VA side of the MSA.











Demographics of the 2,651 RA soldiers that transitioned to Virginia in FY22.
