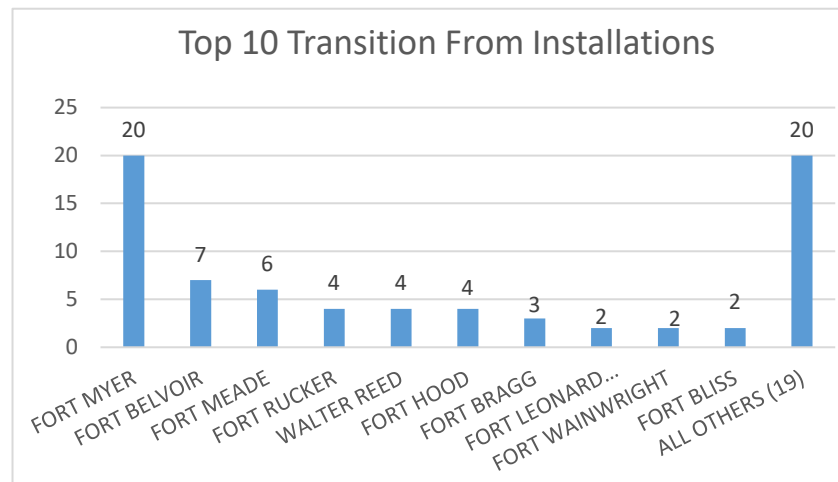
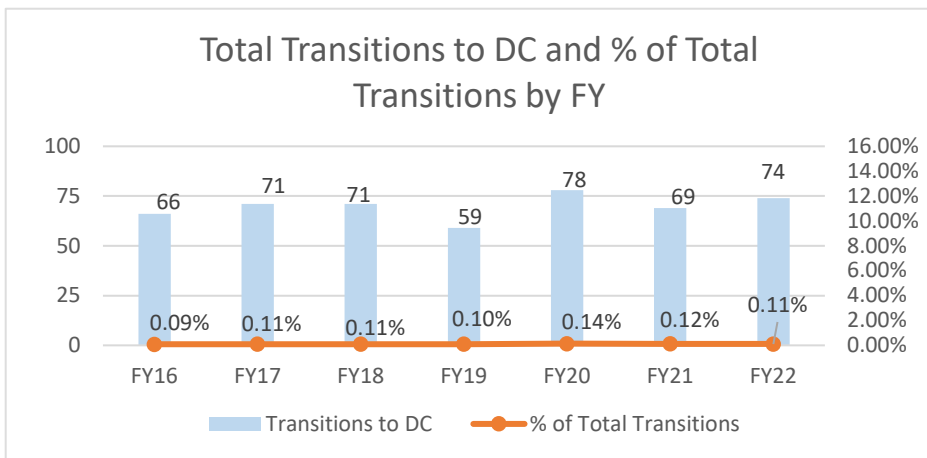

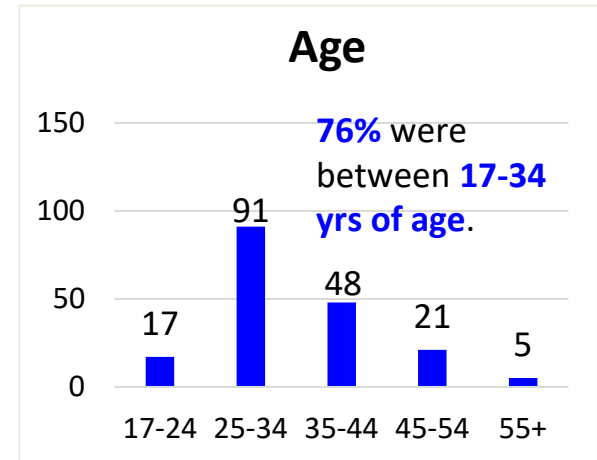

*Note: AAPI= Asian Pacific Islander AI/AN= American Indian/ Alaska Native

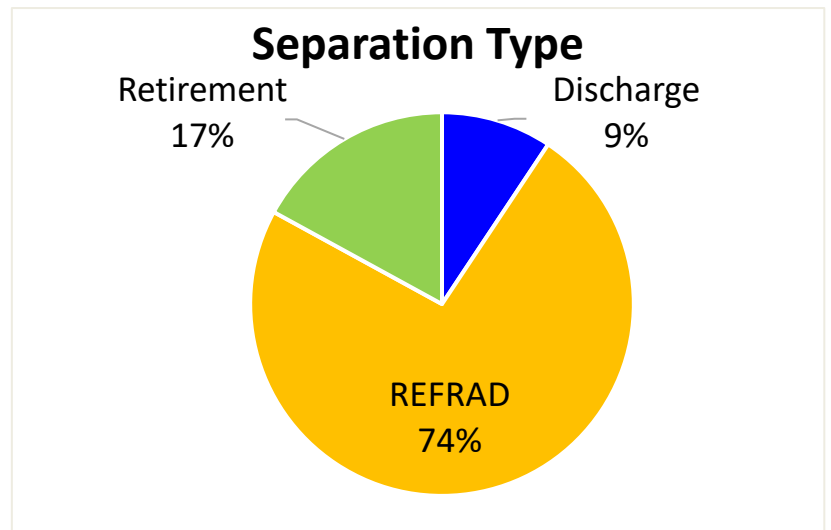
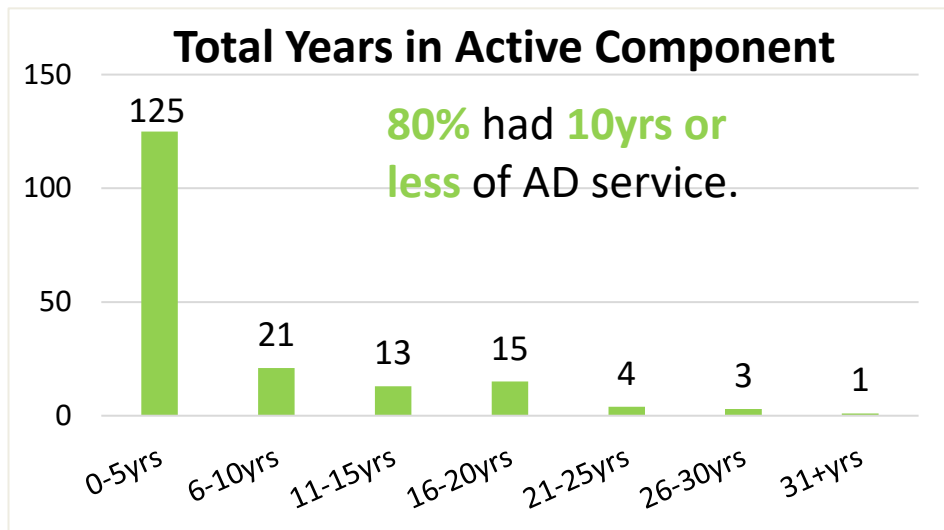
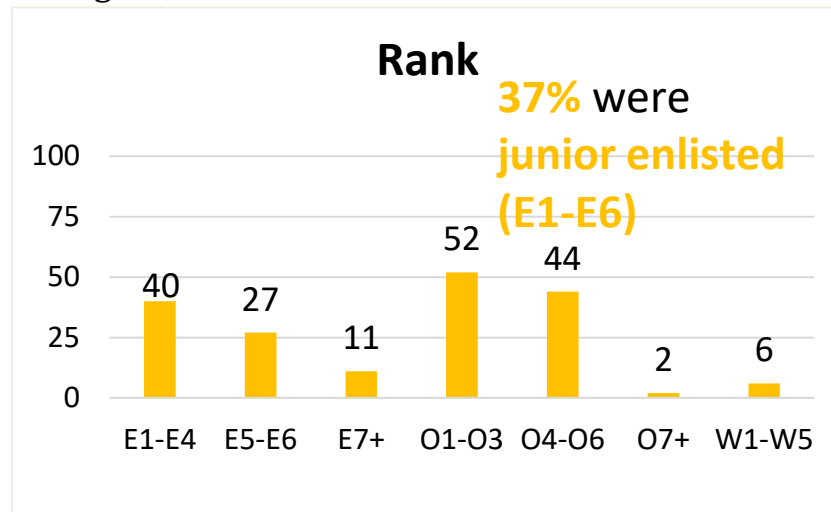
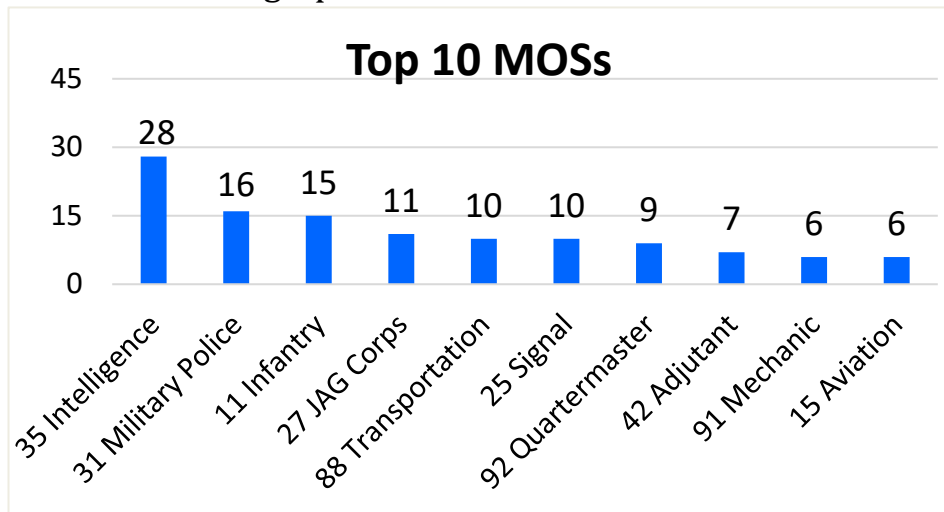
