



West Virginia ranked 41st in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. <1% (224) of the RA population for FY22 transitioned to West Virginia.

## **WV FY22 RA Transitions**

- > 65,864 (left the Army)
- > 379 (Joined in WV)
- 81 (returned to WV; about 79% loss)
- > 143 (outsiders moved to WV)
- **224** to WV





<sup>\*</sup>MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders (Census Bureau). Some MSAs split states however the numbers only reflect those that transitioned to the WV side of the MSA.











Demographics of the 224 RA soldiers that transitioned to West Virginia in FY22.
