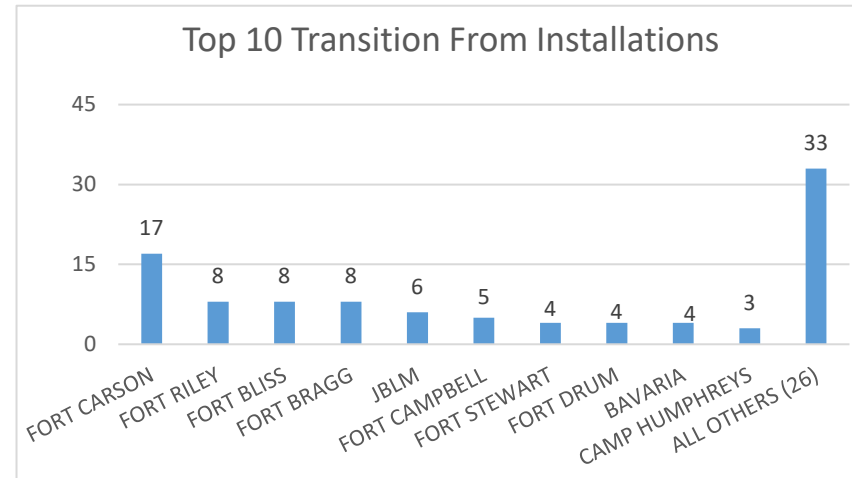
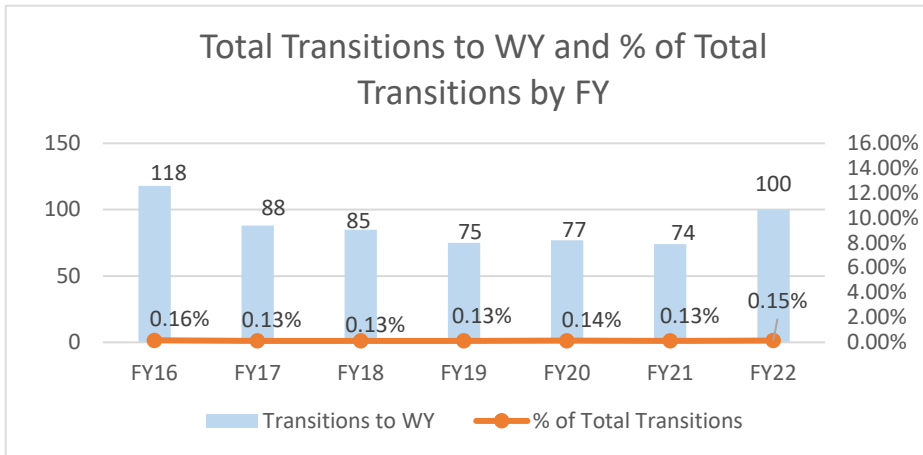
Wyoming ranked 48th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. <1.0% (100) of the RA population for FY22 transitioned to Wyoming.

## WY FY22 RA Transitions

- ❖ **100** to WY



\* MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders. A Micropolitan Area has a population center of at least 10,000 but less than 50,000 (Census Bureau).

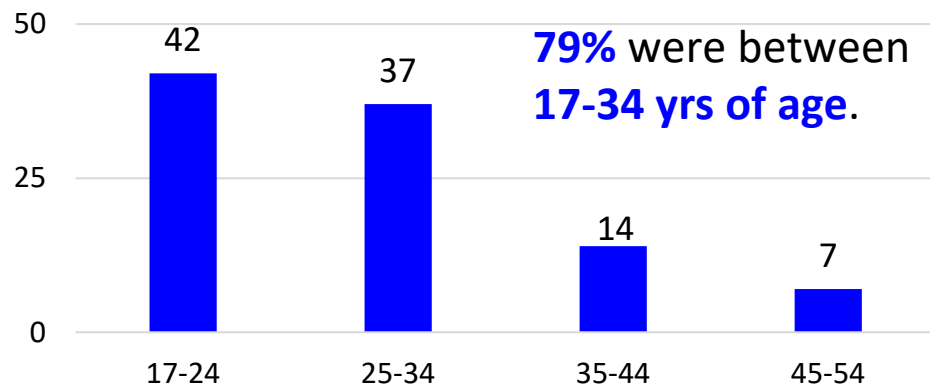

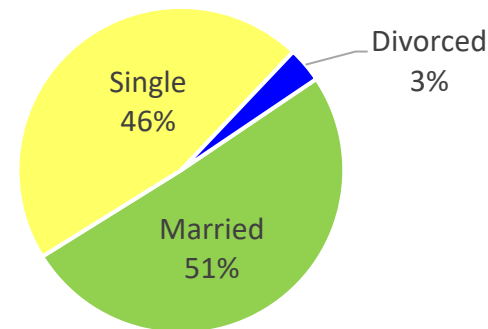


Demographics of the 100 RA soldiers that transitioned to Wyoming in FY22.

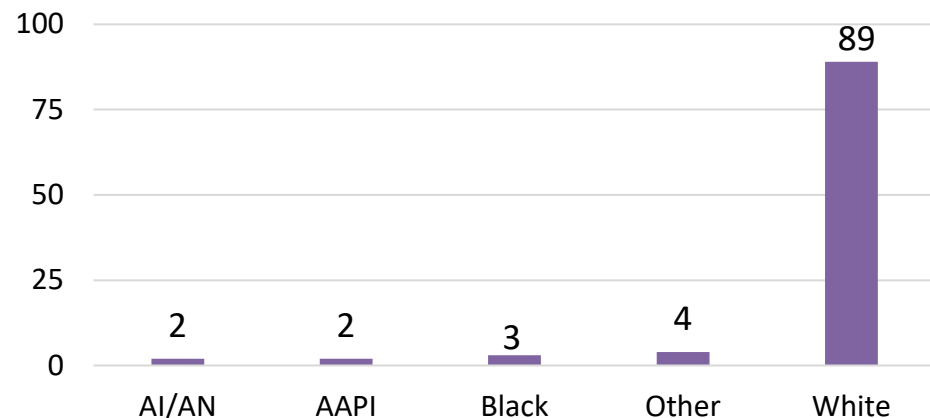

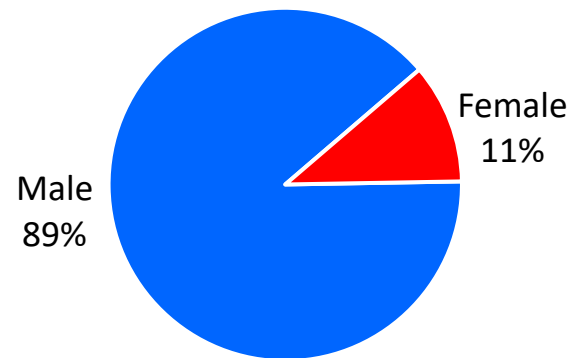
## Marital Status
