






Maine ranked 44th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. <1.0% (141) of the RA population for FY23 transitioned to Maine.










Demographics of the 141 RA soldiers that transitioned to Maine in FY23.









*Note: AI/AN= American Indian/Alaska Native; AAPI= Asian American Pacific Islander; Other= blank, other and unknown








Demographics of RA Soldiers that transitioned to Maine in FY23.
