



Mississippi ranked 32nd in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 1% (373) of the RA population for FY23 transitioned to Mississippi.

- **373** to MS






*MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders. A Micropolitan Area has a population center of at least 10,000 but less than 50,000 (Census Bureau). N/A (Rural) describes an area that is considered a Micropolitan Area, or less in population. Some of the MSAs split states but the numbers only reflect those that transitioned to MS. **ALL** numbers are those with Honorable/general service.








Demographics of the 373 RA soldiers that transitioned to Mississippi in FY23.
