



Montana ranked 45th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. <1.0% (137) of the RA population for FY23 transitioned to Montana.

N/A Rural describes an area that is considered a Micropolitan Area, or less in population. **ALL** numbers are those with Honorable/general service.






Demographics of the 137 RA soldiers that transitioned to Montana in FY23.

Age


76% were between 17-34 yrs of age.




Marital Status
