


New Mexico ranked 34th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 1% (333) of the RA population for FY23 transitioned to New Mexico.



A Micropolitan Area has a population center of at least 10,000 but less than 50,000 (Census Bureau). N/A Rural describes an area that is considered a Micropolitan Area, or less in population. **ALL** numbers are those with Honorable/general service.









Demographics of the 333 RA soldiers that transitioned to New Mexico in FY23.
