



Virginia ranked 7<sup>th</sup> in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 4% (2,405) of the RA population for FY23 transitioned to Virginia.

## **VA FY23 RA Transitions**

- > 59,535 (left the Army)
- > **1,560** (Joined in VA)
- 631 (returned to VA; about 60% loss)
- > 1,774 (outsiders moved to VA)
- **2,405** to VA





\*MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders (Census Bureau). Some MSAs split states however the numbers only reflect those that transitioned to VA. **ALL** numbers are those with Honorable/general service.











Demographics of the 2,405 RA soldiers that transitioned to Virginia in FY23.
