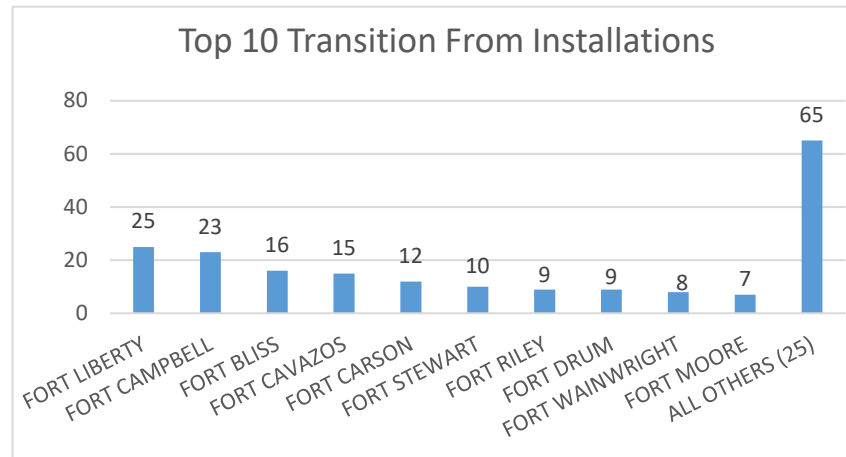
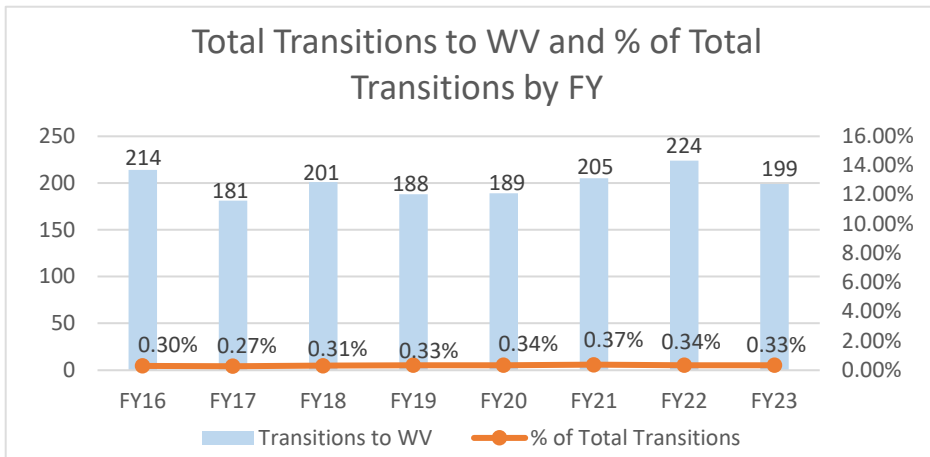


West Virginia ranked 42<sup>nd</sup> in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. <1% (199) of the RA population for FY23 transitioned to West Virginia.

## WV FY23 RA Transitions

- **59,535** (left the Army)
- **358** (Joined in WV)
- **73** (returned to WV; **about 80% loss**)
- **126** (outsiders moved to WV)
- ❖ **199** to WV



\*MSA stands for Metropolitan Statistical Area. A MSA is a predetermined land area that contains a population center with at least 50,000 people residing within its borders (Census Bureau). Some MSAs split states however the numbers only reflect those that transitioned to WV. **ALL** numbers are those with Honorable/general service.



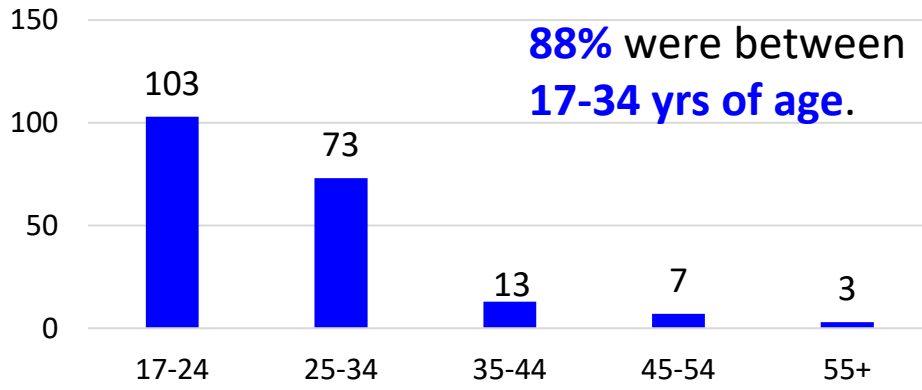

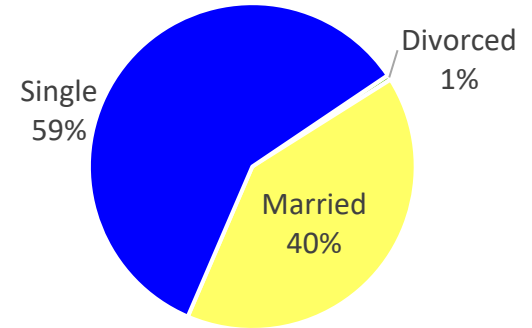
Demographics of the 199 RA soldiers that transitioned to West Virginia in FY23.

## Age

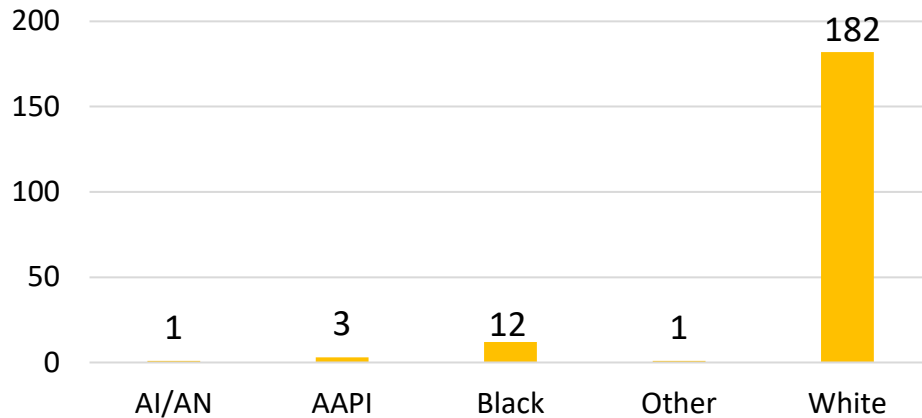
88% were between 17-34 yrs of age.



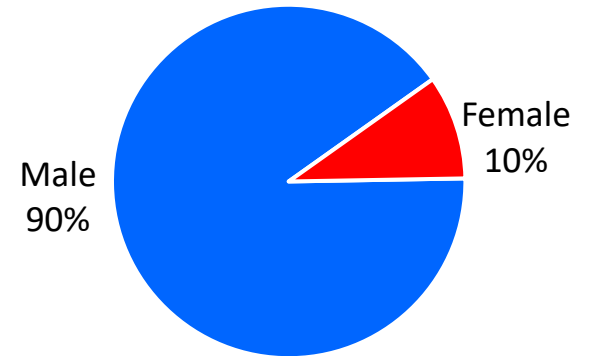
## Marital Status
