



Wyoming ranked 50th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. <1.0% (83) of the RA population for FY23 transitioned to Wyoming.



A Micropolitan Area has a population center of at least 10,000 but less than 50,000 (Census Bureau). N/A Rural describes an area that is considered a Micropolitan Area, or less in population. **ALL** numbers are those with Honorable/general service.










Demographics of the 257 soldiers that transitioned to Wyoming in FY23.
